Peter Pitzele once put it this way - in answer to the question of what he meant by "having fun“:

*When the white fire is lit and the black fire is warmed and illuminated, and when the mind begins to realise it can play freely in new ways of understanding, the heart will open with a certain innocent delight.*

*What was once static is now moving, what was once fixed is now free. From this process, spirit, holy spirit, breathes into us and we feel our imaginative life; we are more in touch with the vitality of the present moment. Intellect and feeling are no longer separate and we feel the touch of joy.*

The Bibliolog Congress 2025 aims to make such creative inspiration both tangible and to gain a deeper understanding of what happens in the process. Two lectures will address two key questions: what happens to the Bible when we engage with it in a creative way, and what happens to us as humans when we do so? The workshops will focus on creative experience, combining Bibliolog with other creative forms such as Bibliolog dance, BiblioArt and Bibliolog with music. They will also explore ways of igniting white fire on multiple levels. You will also have the opportunity to meet other bibliolog practitioners and Peter and Susan Pitzele in digital format.

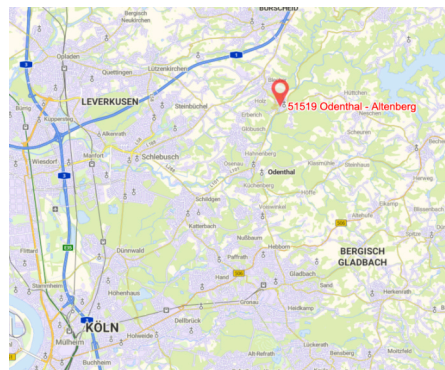
